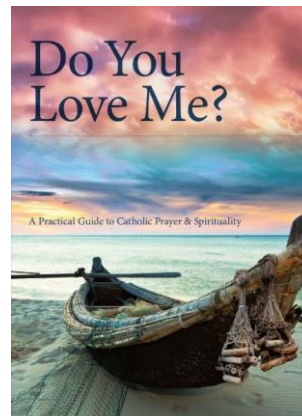

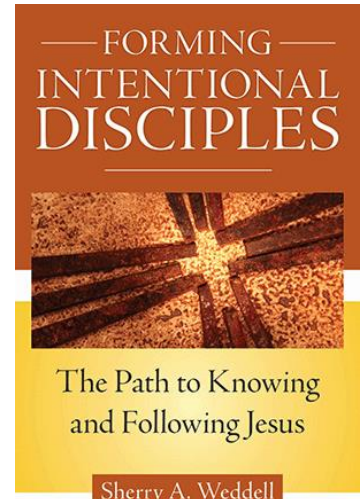

“Forming Intentional Disciples” draws on research into the reasons why 150 adults became Catholics, and not mere members of the Catholic Church but “intentional disciples”, adults mindfully seeking to follow the example and teachings of Jesus. Effectively promoting spiritual growth of Catholic young people depends on nudging them one step at a time on the road to discipleship; the insights of this book are invaluable in focussing worship in Catholic schools in a way which helps our young people make this journey. The teaching is presented by Revd Dr Gareth Leyshon, Director of Adult Education for the Archdiocese of Cardiff, who was first asked to present this material to a national audience by the Bishops of England & Wales at the “Proclaim’15” meeting in Birmingham last July.
