






EMERGENCY FOOD VOUCHER SCHEME

The Archdiocese of Cardiff is launching a new emergency food voucher scheme to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic with support from our funders Barclays Bank, the Albert Gubay Charitable Foundation and the National Lottery Community Fund. The Archdiocese of Cardiff's scheme will provide a safe way of offering people food relief during the pandemic.

How it will work:

-  1. Apply online to obtain food vouchers. You can apply as a parish or on behalf of a parish project e.g. an SVP group or a foodbank.
Deadline for applications: Tuesday 8th December 2020.
-  2. If successful the Archdiocese of Cardiff will email parishes £500 worth of £10 vouchers and potentially more if a faith-based school is applying. You can then email vouchers on to those you want to support or print them out and distribute in person or by post.
-  3. You can decide how best to distribute them. You may want to give ongoing support to a group of people or give out the vouchers as need arises.
-  4. Those who receive vouchers can go to the local supermarket and spend them on what they really need.
-  5. Keep track of details on how you distributed the vouchers, the impact they had, and any other feedback. Report back to the Food Programme Team at the Archdiocese of Cardiff.
